

Rules and Information

- Entry Fees: \$14 per class, \$18 post entry
- Pre-enter by email or phone by Thursday 9 PM before show
- Coggins test dated within 1 year of show date and full payment for classes entered required day of show. Make checks payable to the individual organizer for the show venue you are attending.
- A competitor is considered to be an adult if they are 18 as of 01/01/2010
- **\$5.00 per rider EMT fee charged at EACH show**
- Neat, workmanlike attire, ASTM approved safety helmet with chin strap required.
 - Jackets and braiding are optional.
- **CONTROLLED SCHOOLING: 7:30 am to 8:15 and as noted on prizelist.**
- Decision of the judge or show manager is FINAL.
- Management reserves the right to combine, cancel, split or re-arrange order of classes as needed to keep show day running smoothly.
- Ribbons awarded for 1st thru 6th place in each class with Champion and Reserve in each division.
- Points for registered riders will accrue thru the series and there will be 1st thru 6th place awards presented at the series end banquet for each division.
- In order for your points to count toward year end awards, ALL riders must register. There is a one time \$10.00 registration fee. Trainers must register as well. No points will be recorded unless you are registered! You may ride without registering but your points will not be counted toward series end awards.

LEADLINE – Open to riders 6 years old and under. May only cross enter into Tater Tot.

TATER TOT – Open to all riders not yet cantering in the show ring. Attendants allowed. May only cross enter into walk/trot classes.

LITTLE BRITCHES - Open to riders who are just learning to canter and jump.

APPADIDITT FARM: 1861 Little Conestoga Rd., Elverson, PA 19520 (610) 286-7454
From Rt. 100/23 go west on Route 23. Turn left onto 345 South. Continue straight thru stop sign at Route 401. At next stop sign turn left onto Little Conestoga Rd. Drive one mile to #1861 on right.
From Rt. 401/100: Follow Route 401 West. Turn left onto Fairview Road. Continue 2.4 miles to stop sign and turn right onto Little Conestoga Road. Drive 2.4 miles to #1861 on left.

FOX HOLLOW FARM: 271 Swinehart Rd., Glenmoore, PA 19343 (610) 942-9001
From Rt. 82 & 322 go East on Route 322. Go 9/10 mile past Route 82 and turn right onto Swinehart Rd. Drive ½ mile to Fox Hollow on the right.
From Rt. 322 and 30 go West on Route 322. Drive for 4 miles to your 4th traffic light. Turn left onto Culbertson Run Rd. Continue 1 mile to the 4 way stop at Swinehart Rd. Turn right onto Swienhart Rd. and continue ¼ mile to Fox Hollow on the left.
