- Neat breeches & boots, ASTM approved safety hard hat with chin strap required
Jackets & braiding optional.
- **Controlled Schooling:** 7:30 AM to 8:15 and at lunch break. For competitors only.
- Dogs (and wayward children) *MUST* be leashed at all times .
- Decision of the judge and/or organizer is **FINAL.**
- Organizers reserve the right to combine, split, cancel or re-arrange order of classes or divisions as they see fit.
- Ribbons awarded 1st through 6th. Champion and reserve in each division.
- Year end series winners awarded at final show .
